Scholarship for Master of Arts in Visual Arts Education and Creative Practice
[MA(VAECPP)] Programme

1. Background

The Department of Cultural and Creative Arts (CCA), The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK) will offer scholarship opportunities for students in the MA(VAECPP) Programme who have achieved outstanding academic performance at EdUHK and intend to pursue further development in visual arts, visual arts education and associated fields starting from the 2020/21 academic year. These scholarships are available for both **local students** and **non-local students** of MA(VAECPP) Programme with outstanding academic achievements and contributions to visual arts/ visual arts education/ associated fields.

2. About the Scholarship

Three scholarships of HK\$10,000 each will be offered per academic year to MA(VAECPP) students. Eligible MA(VAECPP) students will be nominated to apply for the scholarship after releasing assignment grades of first semester studies. The scholarship will be directly used to offset the second payment of tuition fee OR will be offered to the awardees a bearer cheque.

Additional notes:

- *The awardees will be allowed to hold concurrent scholarships as long as the total amount receivable does not exceed the full tuition fee of the Programme.*

3. Selection Criteria

Applicants must:

- Possess outstanding academic result in the MA(VAECPP) Programme (a minimum GPA of 3.0 in the first semester with four courses); and
- Demonstrate a strong track record of achievements in and commitment to visual arts/ visual arts education/ associated fields.

4. Nomination and Selection Procedure

- Eligible MA(VAECPP) students will be invited to apply for the scholarship via email after releasing assignment grades of first semester studies.
- Applicants are required to submit a written proposal and attend the interview and/or presentation.
- A completed application form with all required documents (i.e. written proposal, certificates) must be returned to the MA(VAECPP) Programme Office at mavaecpp@eduhk.hk on or before a stipulated deadline.
- Successful awardees will be notified within two months after the application deadline. The Programme Office reserves the right not to offer any award in any particular academic year.

5. Conditions of Award

- The scholarship may be terminated if the awardee ceases to be a student of the University for whatever reason, or has any misconduct. The awardee shall refund to the University the full amount of the scholarship received.
- The awardees shall refund to the University the full amount of the scholarship received if they are not able to successfully graduate from the MA(VAECPP) Programme within the maximum study period allowed according to the Academic Guidelines of the University.
- The awardees are required to attend all invited functions related to the scholarship.
- The decision of EdUHK is final and binding.

6. Handling of Information and Personal Data

The information collected from the applicant will be used for processing the “Scholarship for MA(VAECPP)”. The collected data will be purged after one year. Please note that it is mandatory for the applicant to provide the personal data required or we might not process his/her request. The personal data captured might be transferred or shared with “other unit(s)” of EdUHK but will not be transferred to outside parties. The applicant has the right to request access to and correction of information held by us.
